



Vacant Great Western Trail Authority Board Seat

The Town of Severance is now accepting letters of interest for a vacant seat on the Great Western Trail Authority (GWTA) Board. The Great Western Trail Authority is a local government entity, created by an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) between the towns of Windsor, Severance & Eaton to accept the donation of the abandoned Great Western Railway between the towns under the "railbanking" provisions of the 1983 amendments to the National Trails System Act. The Authority's ongoing responsibility is to plan and construct a public trail on the right-of-way, maintain the trail corridor, and seek funding for the trail through grants and contributions. The GWTA board consists of nine volunteer members, three from each of the IGA towns.

The appointment is a four-year term that will expire in April 2022. A member of the GWTA must be a resident of the Town of Severance for a minimum of two years prior to their appointment. Letters of interest explaining your qualifications and intent should be addressed to the Mayor and Town Board of Trustees, Attn: Nicholas Wharton, Assistant Town Administrator, and may either be sent to Severance Town Hall, 3 S.
